Radical Healing Collaborative Launches Primary Care Services

The LGBTQ+ and BIPOC-centered campus for healing and wellness will open a primary care clinic in Durham, North Carolina, on September 16th, 2024

<u>The Radical Healing Collaborative</u>, an integrative health and wellness campus in Durham and Chapel Hill, North Carolina, is opening a primary healthcare clinic in September 2024.

The primary healthcare clinic is Health at Every Size-aligned, trauma-informed, client-centered, and deeply rooted in racial and economic equity. The Collaborative accepts many insurance plans, accepts self-pay clients, and offers a sliding scale. Options for care include accessible in-person and remote visits, clinical translation services, and options for low-stimulation / sensory-friendly office visits.

Already a leader in radically inclusive community wellness, the organization will continue to center queer, trans, and BIPOC folx while providing high-quality care to all. Providers will support a wide range of healthcare needs including acute and preventive care, sexual and reproductive health care, gender care, chronic illness treatment, and psychiatric medication management. "My hope is that primary care at Radical Healing will feel like a trusted partner in the health journey," says collaborating physician Dr. Rakhee Devasthali (she/her). "And a space our patients know they can come to for compassionate and accessible care, health information, and guidance."

Operating out of Durham's Lakewood neighborhood, the primary healthcare clinic is the latest expansion of Radical Healing's thriving community hub. Since 2016, Radical Healing has expanded from a small collective of independent healing practitioners to become The Radical Healing Collaborative - a mental health clinic led by Dr. Della V. Mosley (she/her) and David Young Oh (she/her/he/him) to meet the great need for more free and accessible therapy while offering emerging mental health practitioners opportunities to train using an anti-oppression and social justice lens. "At its heart, Radical Healing is a tribute and love letter to the collective care and wisdom of BIPOC, queer, and trans folx," says Young Oh, who founded Radical Healing's original iteration after being inspired by the radical community care she received in her home community of New Orleans.

In addition to The Radical Healing Collaborative's new primary care services, the organization continues to offer mental health services, movement facilitation, art groups, psychotherapy groups, educational community programming, and soon, psychedelic medicine. The Collaborative's 60+ practitioners include bodyworkers, nurses, counselors, artists, activists, caregivers, scholars, and energy workers.
